

Accessorial Charges October 2013



Sutco Contracting Ltd. reserves the right to change or adjust any accessorial charge without notice.

1. ADDITIONAL LABOUR CHARGES:

If additional labour is required to complete a job it will be charged at a rate of \$40 per hour per person. Minimum of 4 hours charged per person. This charge is in addition to any charges levied for carriers equipment/employee time as outlined in item 11. After hours callout time may be subject to additional charges.

2. ADDITIONAL SERVICES (CRANE, PILOT CAR, ETC):

Any additional services booked and coordinated by Sutco will be billed to the customer at the rate of the service plus 10%.

3. ADDITIONAL DELIVERY:

An additional charge of \$100 will apply when a customer chooses to pay a truckload rate to the furthest point and requires multiple deliveries at different locations within the same city or within different cities. Should the additional delivery(s) require off route miles, a mileage charge based on the rate being charged to the final destination will apply.

4. ADDITIONAL PICKUP:

An additional charge of \$100 will apply when a customer chooses to pay a truckload rate to the furthest point and requires multiple pickups at different locations within the same city or within different cities. Should the additional pickup(s) require off route miles, a mileage charge based on the rate being charged to the final destination will apply.

5. AFTER HOURS DELIVERY AND OR PICKUP:

Should an after-hours service be required, charges may apply depending on location and timing, please confirm with your Sutco representative.

6. C.O.D. SERVICE:

If Sutco is instructed to pick up cash or a certified cheque from the consignee before the freight may be delivered is subject to the following charges: 6% of the C.O.D. amount, minimum \$100 charge.

7. CUBE RULE:

All less than truckload rates are subject to 15 pounds per cubic foot, unless otherwise specified. If the cubic weight is more than the actual weight of the shipment then the cubed weight shall apply to calculate the freight charges. When it is not possible to load on top of a shipment the cube dimensions for the shipment shall be based on a minimum height of 8 feet. On flat deck equipment deck space will be charged at a minimum of 1000 lbs. per foot of deck space.

8. DECLARED VALUATION:

Maximum liability of carrier is \$2.00 per pound unless declared valuation on original Bill of Lading states otherwise. Declared valuation in excess of \$2.00 per pound is subject to the following valuation charge: 50 cents per hundred dollars of declared value beyond \$2.00 per pound of shipment. Carrier must be advised prior to shipping of a declared value beyond \$2 per pound. Carrier reserves the right to decline any shipment with a high value at its sole discretion.

9. TARPING SERVICE:

If tarping is required it will be subject to the following charges:

\$100.00 per occurrence.

Carrier reserves the right to decline tarp service if in carrier/driver opinion the freight will damage the tarps.

10. OVERDIMENSIONAL SERVICE:

Additional charges shall apply, confirm with your Sutco Rep before shipment.

11. HOURLY CHARGES:

Tractor, trailer, and driver: tractor running \$125 per hour rounded up to the nearest quarter hour.

Tractor, trailer, and driver: tractor not running \$85 per hour rounded up to the nearest quarter hour.

12. FUEL SURCHARGE (FSC):

Rates and charges are subject to current fuel surcharge in effect at the time of shipping.

13. HEATED SERVICE:

If heated service is required then the shipment shall be subject to a "heated service" charge of 15% of the base rate. Minimum charge of \$100. This service is also subject to current FSC in place at time of shipping.

14. TRAILER DEMURRAGE:

Charges shall vary by location; rates should be confirmed with Sutco prior to booking.

15. TAXES:

All shipments are subject to applicable taxes levied by any level of government.
